**MINUTES OF A PUBLIC HEARING

Chairman Debnam called the public hearing to order for the purpose of receiving public comments on the proposed Cashiers Transportation Plan.

Gerald Green, Planning Director, stated the Cashiers Transportation Plan has been endorsed by the Cashiers Area Chamber of Commerce and approved by the Planning Board and the Cashiers Village Council. The goals and projects identified in the Plan are the roadway, pathway, and policy projects. The goal of the Village Council and others involved in development of the Plan was that it becomes a part of the County's Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP).

**Public Comments:** Lou Blanc of Cashiers stated he supports the Plan; however, his property fronts Frank Allen Road which gets flooded frequently and he has concerns about how the new sidewalk will affect his property.

There being no further public comments, Commissioner Greene moved that the hearing be adjourned. Commissioner Jones seconded the Motion. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
